Tribute to Fallen Soldiers Memorial Torch and Motorcycle Ride

For the second year in a row the “Tribute Ride”, an organization dedicated to honoring our fallen soldiers, has chosen Elks Lodge 298 to host its Riders on July 19th. Warren Williamson, Executive Director of the “Tribute Ride”, stated that the goal of his organization is to travel to every corner of the country to honor our fallen soldiers. The ride begins in Oregon and travels by different routes throughout the country to eventually arrive at Arlington National Cemetery where a wreath is laid at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Memorial Torch will be extinguished.

In the last twelve years he and his motorcycle entourage has honored nearly 1000 men and women by presenting plaques to the soldiers’ families. Mr. Williamson discussed the “mission” of the group and spoke about several of the sixty families they will visit this year.

Locally, Army Staff SGT Nathan M. Cox of Walcott was honored.

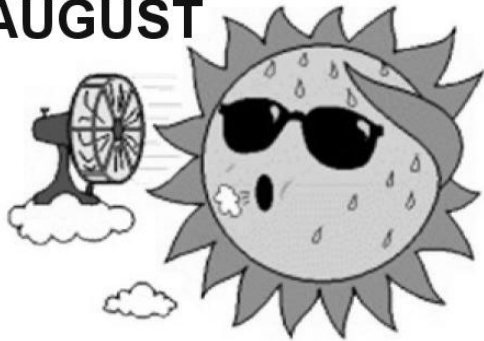
