I have been an Elk and a Member of this Lodge since October of 2016. When I was Initiated into the Order, I was just returning home to San Luis Obispo and finalizing my retirement from the Federal Bureau of Prisons (FBOP). My FBOP career path took me and Daphne away from San Luis Obispo for fourteen years, Danbury, CT, and Victorville, CA. My family moved to San Luis Obispo when I was seven and we lived on Camp San Luis Obispo until I was attending Cuesta College. My parents were not Elks, but I spent my Scouting years with Troop 322.

In 2017 I retired from the Federal Bureau of Prisons, I served 23 years and attained the rank of Lieutenant. More than half of my time I was a shift Lieutenant and supervised responses to emergencies in the institutions I was assigned to. During my career I was stationed at three facilities, the United States Penitentiary in Lompoc, CA, the Federal Correctional Institution in Danbury, CT, and the Federal Correctional Complex in Victorville, CA.

I was also a reservist for 32 years serving in the California Army National Guard and the United States Army Reserve. I started as a Private and retired as a Lieutenant Colonel. In the National Guard, I was an Infantry Officer. In addition to training for war, I participated in response to floods, fires, riots, and counter-drug operations. In the Army Reserve, I was a Civil Affairs Officer and conducted counter-insurgency operations in Iraq and Afghanistan.

Before retiring I was encouraged to become a member of the order by my Mother-in-Law who was working through the Chairs in the Santa Barbara Lodge. I must recognize her Sally Mott, Past Exalted Ruler, Santa Barbara Lodge #613, 2018 - 2019. My goal was to be a part of this Lodge, enjoy the benefits, and see where I could volunteer. The first opportunity the Lodge gave me was an opportunity to be a Scout Leader in the Troop 322. Later the Lodge supported a Charter for the first Scouts BSA Girl Troop in San Luis Obispo. Every member should be proud that their Lodge was the first in San Luis Obispo and that we are supporting a Scout that will be in the first class of female Eagle Scouts.

I was thrilled to be appointed Lodge Esquire for the 2019 - 2020 Elk year and decided to begin my path up through the chairs. I want to contribute in a significant way to the success of the Lodge for the membership. The leadership rolls, operational experience, and education I achieved in my professional life give me the tools to serve you and the Lodge. I am open to input from any Member of the Lodge. 2020 Scholarship Awards Results

Were you aware that the Elks have been awarding scholarship to students since 1933? Each year, The Elks National Foundation awards 500 Most Valuable Student Scholarships to outstanding high school seniors who demonstrate scholarship, leadership and financial need. The top 20 winners receive scholarships ranging from \$20,000 to \$50,000 over four years. The remaining 480 runners-up receive \$4,000 scholarships over four years.

San Luis Obispo Elks Lodge #322 has been an ardent participant and supporter of this program and has annually provided scholarships to our local outstanding students and then advances six selected students to the district level. From the district level the students can advance to the state and then national level. At each level cash awards are awarded.

This year, the scholarship committee awarded \$12,500 to fourteen very talented and deserving students from San Luis High, and Morro Bay High. Of those fourteen, the committee selected six students to advance to the district. Much to the committee's pleasure, all six of our students we sent to the district level were advanced to the state level. Unfortunately, none of them were advanced to the national level.

As all of you are quite aware, the Shelter-In-Place order has derailed many an event. It is with great sadness that the annual awards banquet where the awards and handed out to these students are publicly recognized has had to be canceled.
