

Homeless Stand Down at the Roseburg VA Med Center

The Roseburg VA hosted the first "Stand Down" in five years focusing on homeless veterans. Scott Harvey, VAVS Rep, along with Todd Lund Deputy Rep from the Roseburg Elks Lodge planned and coordinated a BBQ lunch for Veterans that attended the stand down on 9/11/2024.

Food was provided by the funding we received from OSEA and new BBQs were provided by the Myrtle Creek Lodge through a Grant they donated to the Roseburg VA.

Along with 14 Elk volunteers we served over 240 hot dogs and hamburgers on a cool and slightly rainy day. Food was prepared and transported to the event by the Roseburg Elks and the grilling was handled by Joel Buoy and Tom Davis of the Roseburg Lodge. Along with the hot dogs and hamburgers there was potato salad, chips and soda provided.

Scott Harvey also provided 10 cots with a built-in tent that is packable and light weight, so when the homeless move from their encampment they can take their cots with them.

The total amount spent by Scott as the VAVS Rep to the Roseburg VA Medical Center was more than \$2500 all made possible through his budget received from Elks National Veteran Services Commission (ENVSC).



I haven't written an article for the newsletter about the **Elks National Foundation** in a while, but looking at several reports from Grand Lodge, I thought it was time. While we are doing a **very good job** with our donations, we can always do better. One report shows around 25 members that have donated in the past, but for one reason or another have not donated for a few years. We need you back!

In case you have forgotten, here is a reminder of what the ENF does. It finances <u>all</u> of the Elks programs above the lodge level. This includes our Drug Awareness, Scholarship, Veterans, Hoop Shoot, and Community Investment programs, along with grants to the state associations for their major project. Which for Oregon is the Elks Youth Eyes Services. E.Y.E.S. provides support for our Oregon Elks Children Eye Clinic in Portland, eye screening for pre-school kids,

and the Bend Eye Clinic.

The **Community Investment Program** provides support to Elk lodges. Over the years Roseburg has received thousands of dollars to help our community. Just this year alone, we have received \$11,000 from ENF while only donating \$2,500. Where else are you going to get that kind of return! The money was used to help finance our John Little Kids Shopping Spree, help to our veterans and this month we will give \$4,000 to five different non-profits in the Roseburg area. Speaking of that, on **October 11th**, come down to the lodge for dinner and see what this money is being used for. Representatives are invited to dinner, will receive their \$800.00 check and tell us how the money is being used at their non-profit organization. 




