ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION NEWS- FEB-MARCH 2023

These are the last 2 months of the Elks fiscal year which ends March 31,2023. Donations from our Lodge to ENF stand at \$6,368.25 this puts our Lodge in the number 2 position among the Vermont Lodges in terms of donations. We now have 196 donors an increase on 8 donors from the Dec-Jan Bulletin. Thank you to the new donors.

In the Dec- Jan Bulletin we reported that the Lodge received a \$3,000 Gratitude Grant from ENF to help with the costs of the Community Thanksgiving Dinner which served over 1,000 dinners to shut ins and those that might not have a Thanksgiving Dinner. Since then I am pleased to report that our Lodge has received a \$2,000 ENF Spotlight Grant and a \$4,000 ENF Gratitude Grant. With these Grants, sizable donations will be made to 3 local non-profits who work with Veterans, Support the aged and infirm and provide food to the needy. The names of these organizations will be reported in the next bulletin as the presentations will not be made until early February. These donations will make a difference in our community.

Think about this- we have received Grants from ENF with a total value of \$9,000 to help us make a difference in our community, in addition we may have some Scholarship Funding coming. Our donations to ENF are currently at \$6,368.25 that means we have already received \$1.41 in Grants for each \$1.00 donated. What better place is there for your donations than ENF. For those 190 Members who have already donated- THANK YOU! If you haven't yet donated please do it now- only 2 months left.

SCHOLARSHIP CHAIR INTERVIEW

This past December the Bennington Elks Lodge had the pleasure of interviewing a previous winner of the MVS Scholarship. This interview took place following the scholarship judging season. Aditi Patel is a senior at Brown University in Providence, Rhode Island. She is studying Biomedical Engineering and Biochemistry with a focus on teaching STEM to students of all ages and backgrounds. Through the MVS scholarship Aditi has made lasting connections with numerous Elks lodge members, students, and networks. During the interview, Aditi shared how the scholarship has allowed her to focus on her studies and truly explore her interests, as well as the future she envisions. She has been introduced to fellow MVS scholarship winners from other Elks lodges and together they have built their own sense of community. Many of these scholars have developed strong foundations with each other and support one another throughout the school year. Through Elks support and Elks network opportunities, Aditi has assisted with a variety of community outreach programs. Some programs addressed food insecurity for low-income residents of Providence, while others have supported students in their learning paths. She has joined programs close to her school which support the local community she lives in. Aditi even went on a Service Trip to Tampa Bay, Florida where she worked on Hurricane Ian relief projects with other Elks scholars. Thanks to the Elks scholarship program and network, Aditi has met many people from all over the United States, has broadened her horizons, and now seeks to give back to her Bennington Community. She aims to do this by learning about different outreach programs, making learning more accessible to students, and sharing her experiences from living and working in other parts of America. At the end of the interview, Aditi shared how she enjoys living in Providence, but cannot wait to get back to the trees and mountains of our Green Mountain State.
