Who may apply:

- High School students who will graduate Spring 2024
- The scholarship is available to students who are planning to pursue vocational/technical training at an accredited post-secondary school.
- The program being pursued must be one that will culminate in a certificate, diploma, or associate's degree.

The Scholarship:

- The application must be complete, including transcripts and a letter of recommendation at the time of submission.
- The monies are sent directly to the school of enrollment and can be used for tuition, fees, books, and supplies and can only be used toward the expenses of the academic year for which it was intended.
- Applications are evaluated based on the information contained within the application.

Application Judging:

- Applications will be judged on student performance, extracurricular activities, goals, essay, and letter of recommendation (from teacher or instructor).
