Happy May! This brings us more events, one being the Mother's Day Plant Sale! We will be carrying our flag for the VFW in their annual Memorial Day parade. June is Flag Day and another parade. Come out and join us.

May 16th through the 19th is the Spring Convention. June 4th is our next Lodge meeting at 7 pm.

Now for an update on some business that we need to take of. Unfortunately Grand Lodge sent us a bill for Elks Property Plus insurance. The policy renewal came in and the yearly total \$12,980.00. This is with a change to \$10,000.00 deductible. We can either pay it in full or give them a a down payment \$3,247.25 and 9 payments of \$1,125.25 with a finance charge \$385.50. This year there is a notice that Lodges can change coverage from 100% to 80%. To top this off, our 1st payment is due Sunday, May 5th. This comes after we just had to pay Grand Lodge nearly \$10,000.00 in dues per capita. So, if you're wondering where all of our money is going... In closing, we made it through last year and will make it through this one as well.

Check to see if your dues are paid for this year 2024-2025. Dues are \$107.00 for regular members and \$77.00 for life members. The annual dinner will be in June for members with paid up dues.

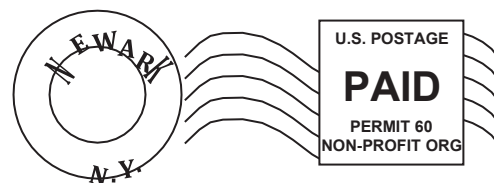
ELKS CARE - ELKS SHARE
