Once again, our Lodge has been awarded the **Gratitude Grant** - a grant that is largely dependent on contributions to **ENF** from our members. This year we received \$2,500. In February \$1,500 was contributed to the Humane Society of Wayne County spay/neuter program. \$1,000 was used to purchase food to help stock the shelves at the Newark Food Closet.

Thank you to everyone who contributes to ENF. If you are wondering if your money is beneficial, it certainly is. We receive more in grant money than what we donate - as long as we continue to donate!

As always, we have collection boxes for the Newark Food Pantry, Veterans, and The Humane Society. During these challenging times, some individuals and families are having a difficult time providing food for their pets. In an effort to help, the Humane Society of Wayne County is working in conjunction with the Office of Aging and Youth to provide dog and cat food. Meals-on-Wheels and the ARC are helping with the distribution. Any and all donations of cat food and/or dog food (any variety) would be much appreciated. Cash donations to the HSWC for that purpose would also be appreciated. Pet food can be taken directly over to the shelter or can be brought to the Lodge and we will deliver to them.
