VETERAN RESOURCES



Veterans who are homeless or at imminent risk of becoming homeless can call or visit their local VA Medical Center or Community Resource and Referral Center where VA staff are ready to help. Ask to speak to a social worker and let them know if you are falling behind on rent, mortgage, or utilities.

If you're not sure where to start, Veterans and their families may call **1-877-4AID-VET** (1-877-424-3838) to access VA services. It's free, confidential, and available 24/7. You'll get access to trained VA counselors and get info about VA homeless programs, health care, and other services in your area.

Find a **Veteran's Service Officer (VSO)** to help you write and submit your benefits claim to the VA. VSO services are free. Call 888-777-4443, and the National Veterans Foundation will help you locate a VSO near you.

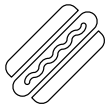
