## This Month's History Tidbit...

On April 22, 1889 at precisely high noon, the Oklahoma Land Rush began. Thousands of would-be settlers made a mad dash into the newly opened Oklahoma Territory to claim cheap land.

At 11:50 a.m., soldiers called for everyone to form a line. When the hands of the clock reached noon, the cannon of the fort boomed, and the soldiers signaled the settlers to start. With the crack of hundreds of whips, thousands of Boomers streamed into the territory in wagons, on horseback, and on foot. Approximately 55,000 settlers entered the territory that day. By nightfall, they had staked thousands of claims either on town lots or quarter section farm plots. Towns like Norman, Oklahoma City & Guthrie sprang into being almost overnight.
