
After Dinner They tried their hand at the backyard games that were set-up out back. It was a great weekend and many thanks to the many volunteers that made it a success!

In August, we shopped for the contents of our first round of "food packs" that we provide to Jameson Elementary School in Old Orchard Beach, using our \$2,000 Spotlight Grant. This is a great way to ensure that children in our local community have food over the weekend when they do not have access to school lunches.
