"To our absent members."







HOUSE RULES :

- 5. All persons issued key cards by this Lodge will use them to gain entrance to the Lounge in lieu of knocking, and thus taking lounge employees from their regular duties to answer the door. ONLY Officers, members of the House Committee, or the Attendant in Charge are allowed to respond to persons knocking to gain entrance.
- 6. Members, spouses, and dependents with identification cards may be requested to exhibit their cards to a Lodge Officer, or a member of the House Committee, or the Attendant in Charge. Visiting members must show their membership cards, sign the guest register, and observe all House Rules. At the discretion of the House Committee, visiting Elks may be given a complimentary drink.
- 7. Guests who are eligible for membership in the Order, but who are not spouses of members and who reside within the jurisdiction of this Lodge, can be admitted as guests occasionally, regardless of who brings them in.
