



Pursuant to Governor Abbott's Executive Order #27 issued this date please be aware of the following:

Social Quarters

All Lodges are required to be closed by 12 Noon today until further notice.

All Lodges have a 51% license that falls into the "bar" category of permittee as recently published during phase II.

Meetings

People should not be in groups larger than ten and should maintain six feet of social distancing from those not in their group, unless otherwise provided such as outdoor gatherings.

For any outdoor gathering in excess of 100 people, other than those set forth above in paragraph numbers 1, 2, or 4, the gathering is prohibited unless the mayor of the city or the county judge in the case of a gathering in an unincorporated area, approves of the gathering.

Food / Alcohol To Go

Alcohol To Go waiver speaks only to restaurants but a waiver includes Mixed Beverage Permittees with permanent kitchens affected by the pandemic

- MB permittees may not sell for customer pick-up or delivery any alcoholic beverage in a container that is sealed by the MB or any person other than the product manufacturer.
- All distilled spirits are delivered in a manufacturer-sealed container that is 375 milliliters or less.

Food service can continue if served in drive thru, pickup, or delivery.

Outside Activities / Pools

There are conflicting portions of the Executive Order and clarification is being sought. At the present reading, a pool within the TABC permit area may be open, but service of food or soft drinks would be prohibited as that would make the "Bar" open even for non-alcoholic beverages.

We understand the impact of this as we were trying to get open and back to normal. Please contact one of us for any updates, questions, or comments as we are in touch with various agencies on a daily basis.
