CARES has an innovative market – a small, non-profit grocery store where all the profits are returned to the agency to increase it's financial capacity. A great place to shop!

Beacon Grants: \$3,500 grants available to every Lodge.

Gratitude Grants: \$2,000-\$3,000 grants available to Lodges who met the 2020-21 per-member-giving goal and additional bonuses. Visit the CIP Participation Report to see if your Lodge has qualified.

Spotlight Grants: \$2,000 grants available to every Lodge. Merge with the Beacon Grant for a \$5,500 grant!

Impact Grants: Up to \$10,000 grants awarded to Lodges based on a competitive, two-step application process. The first step requires interested Lodges to submit an Impact Intent by August 31, 2021. Then, select Lodges will be invited to submit a full application for funding consideration.
