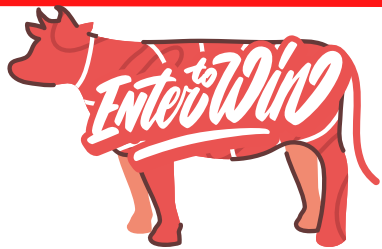
On another note, I would like to thank Mandy and Belinda for all the countless hours you put into keeping the Elks Lodge going, I appreciate it.
