MEET YOUR OFFICERS



This month we are pleased to introduce you to Susan Manning. Susan has been an Elk for 13 years. During that time, like so many of our volunteers, she has helped with cooking Tuesday night's dinners as well as other Lodge functions. She has served as Inner Guard, and in 2011 was elected Secretary for our Lodge and held that position for seven years. In April of 2018, she was elected to a 5 year term as a Trustee where she is currently serving. Not only has Susan volunteered her services to our Lodge, but she has twice received the Citizen of the Year award for her work with Treasure Coast Hospice.

Thank You Bob Scott

As most of you know, Bob Scott has worn several hats in our Lodge. For the past couple years he has been our kitchen manager and has cooked numerous fine meals for us. He and his team cooked Italian night dinners the first Tuesday of every month, burger night one Wednesday every month as well as cooking for any number of our Lodge functions. He has made the Veterans breakfasts and provided coffee and donuts most every week for our veterans. This is only a portion of his many accomplishments.

To save our Lodge money, every week he drove to West Palm Beach to Restaurant Depot to purchase the food for every one of our events. On each round trip of more than 75 miles, he used his own vehicle and never once put in for reimbursement for his gasoline or other expenses. He has donated not only his time and effort, but funds out of his pocket, and has paid for entire meals from time to time. My guess is that he spent well over 90 hours every month working for our Lodge without compensation, and hundreds of dollars in expenses without ever requesting reimbursement. Whenever a team was not available to cook in the kitchen, Bob was there to cover for them.

Bob has also given of his time and talents as a member of the House Committee and as a Trustee on the Board of Directors.

Bob has recently stepped down from all these positions for a much needed break. It will be a major task to replace Bob Scott for all he has done for us and I for one cannot thank you enough Bob, and want you to know the door to any of these positions will always be open to you.
