The Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks celebrated our 156th birthday on February 16, 2024. We are a charitable organization consisting of approximately 2000 Local Lodges nationwide. We are an exclusively an American organization that is dedicated to serving our country and our communities. The principles of our order are, Charity, Justice, Brotherly Love and Fidelity.

Since February 16, 1868, The Elks have made more than \$12 Billion dollars in donations. Annually, the Elks award college scholarships across the nation totaling nearly \$5 million dollars. The Elks Community Investment Program also awards nearly \$16 Million towards enriching our communities.

The Florida State Elks Association programs include the Florida State Elks Association Youth Camp, Children's Therapy Services, Unmasking Autism, Veterans Services, Scholarships and the Harry-Anna Trust Fund.
