The Captain's Cruise Upperclassmen Scholarship was created for students entering their sophomore, junior, or senior year in college, recognizing limited funds beyond freshman year.

Four components encompass this application:

Component I: Applicant must meet the criteria listed below

- 1) The Applicant must have at least 28 college credits.
- 2) The applicant must have an overall college GPA of 2.75.

Component II: Completion of the application form (page 2)

Component III: A typewritten essay of 400 words. Reflect upon the following three questions in your essay:

- 1) What would you have done differently in high school to prepare for college life?
- 2) What obstacles have you overcome and what have you learned from this experience?
- 3) What habits have you determined to be imperative to successful completion of your college career and how will these habits guide you following graduation?

Component IV: Applicant must provide a **college transcript** showing completion of 28+ credit hours. An unofficial transcript, such as a printed copy, is sufficient. If you have attended more than one college, please provide a copy of each transcript.

****This scholarship is not renewable, however a recipient may apply each year of their college career.**

****For payment of the scholarship, the recipient will need to provide a copy of the tuition bill for the upcoming semester. The check will be written to the institution of higher learning and the recipient.**
