

Puyallup Elks Lodge #1450, Swimming Pool Rules

1. Elks Member or spouse with an Elks identification card **MUST** be present at all times with their guests. Do not send the family down without the Elks member, they will be turned away, even with an annual pool pass
2. All who enter must check in with the Duty Officer or lodge office personnel.
3. At least one adult is required to supervise up to 5 children.
4. **No lifeguard is on duty.** Do not swim alone. Make sure at least one other adult is present while you are swimming.
5. Pool is open depending upon lodge Duty Officer availability:
 - Mondays closed.
 - Tuesdays through Fridays from 10 am to 7 pm.
 - Saturdays from 10 am to 4 pm.
 - Sundays from 10 am to 7 pm.
6. Children under the age of 4 are required to wear a life vest if the parent is not in the water with them.
7. Use the pool at your own risk. We are not responsible for accidents, injuries, or loss of property.
8. Shower before entering the pool.
9. No pets in the pool area.
10. No glass or breakable containers in the pool area.
11. No diving, running, or pushing in the pool area.
12. Non-toilet-trained children must wear swim diapers.
13. No alcoholic drinks or smoking in the pool area.
14. Do not bring food, drinks, tobacco, or gum into the pool. It is OK to picnic at the provided tables.
15. No persons are permitted in the pool if they have or are suspected of having communicable diseases or open wounds, lesions, or sores. Or have had diarrhea in the last fourteen days.
16. Rules are subject to change based on government or Lodge regulations.
17. Management reserves the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at any time and for any reason.
