Elks Lodge Pool Rules

You must check in with the bartender, lifeguard or manager **BEFORE** entering the pool to obtain a wrist band. Do not be offended if we ask for your membership card or pool pass.

Shower before entering water.

No glass or ceramic allowed on pool deck or patio. Ask bartender for a plastic cup.

No smoking on pool deck. Please stay on the patio. Be mindful of children and others around you.

PICK UP ALL TRASH & HELP KEEP OUR PATIO CLEAN!

No pets are allowed in the pool or pool deck.

Do not swim if you have open wounds or experienced diarrhea within previous 2 weeks.

Do not swallow or spit water.

A proper bathing suit is required when entering pool water. Street clothes are not permitted.

Nudity is prohibited – changing is required to be done in the restrooms.

SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK! There is **NOT** always a lifeguard on duty.

Lifeguards are here to help guide patrons and enforce rules.

No talking back to the lifeguard even if you feel it is unjust – please see a manager.

Do not talk to lifeguard who is actively on duty who is on active duty in a lifeguard stand, unless it is a matter of safety. Questions should be addressed to the manager on duty.

No running. No horseplay. No swinging or resting on the deep end divider rope. Do not use the preserver ring as a toy. The buoy is a safety device, not a toy.

We are not responsible for any items left behind. Items left behind will be disposed of.

A pool contaminated by feces shall be closed immediately.

Small children in diapers must have regular diaper changes. Children with waste matter in their diapers will be asked to leave the pool and not return until they are changed. Changing of diapers anywhere except diaper changing stations is prohibited.

No children under the age of 14 are allowed within the pool barriers without adult supervision. You are solely responsible for your own children.

It's expected that all members, guests and children of members, to act in a respectable manner. Any foul language, fighting, provocative actions, or violation of pool rules will not be tolerated. All members of your party will be asked to leave. Please be respectful of children surrounding you.

Management has the authority to close the pool when necessary due to thunderstorms, lightning storms or contamination. Management also has the authority to change the hours of operation when necessary.
