



ELKS SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES



Most Valuable Student Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Current high school seniors who are citizens of the United States
- Applicants **do not** need to be related to a member of the Elks
- High school graduates are not eligible to apply

Award:

- The Elks National Foundation awards (500) four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants
- Male and female students compete separately
- Ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$7,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours) in a U.S. college or university.

Legacy Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Any child, grandchild, stepchild, step-grandchild, or legal ward of a living Elk who joined the Order on or before April 1, 2022, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2022, is eligible to apply. The Elk must also be a paid-up member through March 31, 2025. Great-grandchildren are not eligible.
- The applicant must be a high school senior

Award: \$4,000 scholarship

Eveleth Elks Lodge Scholarships

- 1) Two \$1,000 scholarships awarded to children or grandchildren of current Eveleth Elks members. Applications are printed in the March & April Eveleth Elks Newsletter and need to be submitted by May 15, 2025. Awardees are randomly drawn from all applications, along with two alternates. Students awarded the scholarship need to be full-time (12 or more credits) and have a Grade Point Average of 2.0 (C). Students must submit an official transcript from the school after the first semester or quarter to the Elks to receive the funds. In case the initial awardee(s) are not attending, or do not meet the GPA or enrollment criteria, the alternate(s) will be contacted and if meeting the criteria, will be awarded the scholarship.
- 2) Mike Koenigsberg Student of the Month Memorial Scholarship: \$500 awarded to one graduating senior that was Student of the Month and pursuing a post-secondary degree. Applications are distributed at the Student of the Month meal with a submission deadline of May 15, 2025.
- 3) Mike Koenigsberg Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000 awarded to one graduating senior with an interest in music, theater, and/or arts and pursuing a post-secondary degree. Applications are available at the Student of the Month meal and high school counselors with a submission deadline of March 15, 2025.
