ELKS POOL LEAGUE



MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION

Our Lodge holds one meeting a month except for February, March and April where we are required to have 2. This being said, a candidate for membership might be waiting up to 3 months to get initiated. Once an application is received, that candidate's name is read on the lodge floor at the next meeting and the application is posted on the board in the lower hallway. The application is then reviewed by the investigating committee. Once approved, the candidate's name is then up for ballot at the next month's lodge meeting. Once elected, the candidate will then receive a letter informing him/her that they have been elected. A keycard is also granted to the candidate so they can begin using the facilities while waiting initiation. Once the Orientation and Initiation dates have been scheduled, the candidate will be informed of those dates by email or mail. This was confusing for some after seeing dates of Orientation in the bulletin and I apologize. Only those that have received such information by email or mail are to attend the scheduled ceremonies. Also, the application must have a \$30 initiation fee accompanying it when submitted. Thank you and keep the applications coming in!


