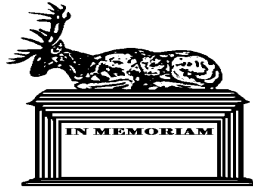

DOOR PRIZE RAFFLE

Here's how it works. Members must be present to sign up for the Door Prize Raffle. When you come into the lounge, step up to the bar and give the bartender your membership number and 50¢. The bartender will write your membership number in a book, which is kept behind the bar. The next morning, after opening, the bartender will have one of the members present draw a number from the raffle drum. If your membership number is drawn and you were registered in the book for the previous day, you win 55% of the money collected, 35% goes to Lodge Charities and 10% goes as a rollover to start the next raffle. The POT (total money collected since the last winner) will be posted and updated weekly. **Play is open to Rochester Elks members only.**

SPECIAL NOTICE

On April 17th the New Hampshire Lottery & Gaming Commission Investigation & Compliance Division notified the Lodge that our YAHTZEE game was not in compliance with the Lottery Rules and Regulations regarding Dice Games. The Lodge immediately discontinued the YAHTZEE game and responded in writing to the commission with our corrective actions. At that time, there was \$1501 in the YAHTZEE POT. The Lottery Commission also questioned the 50 cent JUG game. When it was explained to them that this was simply a DOOR PRIZE RAFFLE, they agreed that this falls under our City Raffle Permit and not under their rules and regulations. **At the May 13th Lodge meeting, Motion** was made by Jerry Skidds, and seconded by Scott Welch to put the YAHTZEE money, \$1501, into the DOOR PRIZE RAFFLE pot and to put an article in the newsletter informing the members. Under discussion, options were discussed as to what would be best to do with the money left in the YAHTZEE POT. One option was to run a separate raffle and put that money in that pot. The second option was to put the money in the DOOR PRIZE RAFFLE (formerly the JUG game). It was decided that this was the best option since most of the members playing the YAHTZEE game also played the JUG game. **Motion was passed** by the members to combine the money from the Pot of the discontinued YAHTZEE game into the DOOR PRIZE RAFFLE Pot. This will be effective July 1st, 2026.
