For 25 years, Mark Meyers has been a dedicated member of the Madera Elks Lodge, consistently demonstrating his commitment to the Elks and to the lodge he proudly serves. During that time, Mark has served as a Trustee for more than 11 years and has twice had the honor of serving as Exalted Ruler. Mark is a person who believes in stepping up when there is work to be done. Most recently, Mark spearheaded the replacement of the lodge's 65-year-old electrical service equipment. Through determination, organization, and hard work, he helped accomplish what seemed nearly impossible completing the entire project in less than three weeks. Mark's 25 years of service reflect more than just time as a member. They represent a willingness to lead, a commitment to his fellow Elks, and a dedication to keeping the Madera Elks Lodge strong for generations to come. Whether serving as an officer, Trustee, or simply rolling up his sleeves to tackle a building project, Mark has consistently demonstrated that when the Elks need him, he steps up.
