Emergency Volunteers

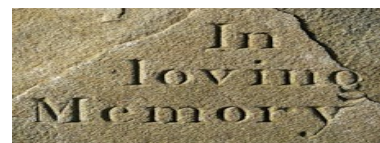
We urgently need dependable volunteers to help keep our kitchen open and serving our community.

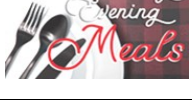

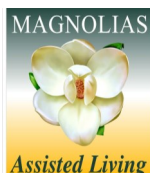
