The Lodge night at the Yard Goats game sold out, thanks to Rich Miskell for setting this up. Proceeds will benefit State Elks Major Projects.

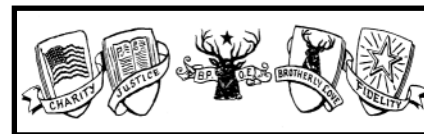

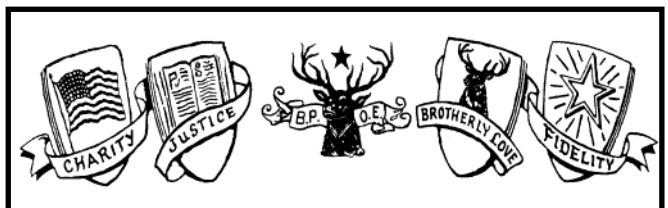
The purpose of the grant application was to assist with the East Hartford Middle School/East Hartford Police Department Holiday gift drive and Holiday Dinner for underprivileged children in East Hartford.

They collect gifts during the year from many sources, including the Stuff A Cruiser annual drive. These gifts are stored at the Middle School, sorted and then wrapped and readied for distribution to specific families who are underprivileged and all of the families living in the East Hartford Women and Family shelter.

As to distribution of the gifts to the families, a Holiday Dinner is held, where dinner is prepared by a local business and served to the families, along with a variety of holiday festivities. Santa and his elves (EHPD Officers) distribute the gifts to the families and each family gets a take home photo.

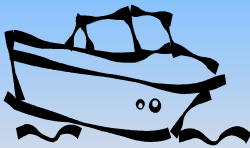
