Last summer we partnered with Sandy's Restaurant and donated items to supplement the student lunches that were prepared and delivered by Sandy's. During this 10 week project, the generosity of our lodge members was overwhelming. It was a shining example of our commitment to helping the community and a testament to the power of kindness. Our donations totaled 274 boxes of assorted items - individual count was 6,470 items with the estimated value at approximately \$2,400.

The project is part of the 'You Matter Movement' and has expanded this year with a goal to prepare and deliver 14,000 lunches and provide weekly meals to 40 families. Besides the lunch supplement items that were donated last year, this year will include bagged pasta, beans, boxed meals, and canned goods (corn, beans, peas, and soups). 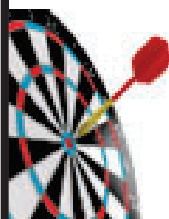
