ADJUSTMENT IN BAR PRICES

Effective May 1, 2026, there will be a slight adjustment to some items on the bar menu.

MICHELOB PRODUCTS

All Michelob products, including draft, Michelob Ultra, and Michelob Golden, will increase by \$0.25. Buckets of Michelob will be \$17.

MIXED DRINKS & SOFT DRINKS

Drinks containing juice will increase by \$0.25 per drink. Soft drinks (soda, pop, including iced tea) will also increase by \$0.25, with free refills. Some additional drinks will be adjusted individually.

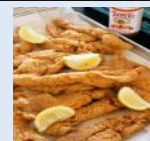
