MESSAGE FROM EXALTED RULER

Greetings Fellow Elks!

In adhering to our motto, "Elks Care, Elks Share", and the Elks Virtue of "Charity", I am pleased to report that the past few months were dedicated to successful fundraisers and charitable programs. We donated 170 backpacks during our "Back-to-School" Program, as well as purchasing clothing, footwear and necessities for school children in need. Backpacks filled with essential school supplies were distributed to Village Green School, Boys & Girls Club, Holy Family Church, and Hibiscus Children's Shelter.

Our Village Green School food pantry is being routinely replenished, stocked with nutritious food for children and families requiring assistance. In addition, members of our Grace Packs Program are dedicated to shopping for healthy groceries for school children who lack, or have insufficient, meals over the weekends. We are expanding our activities to include other significant local charities, such as CareBag (mobile shower units for the homeless). We are actively involved in providing CareBag with necessities and hygiene products for the homeless and their children in our community. Also, we are hosting "Vision for Kids" at our Lodge, offering free vision exams and eyeglasses to children.

In collaboration with the Treasure Coast 10-13 Club, our P.A.L. fundraiser dinner dance on August 8th was an immense success, contributing over \$6,400 to benefit the Port St. Lucie Police Athletic League youth programs. Approximately 200 guests attended, which included our Elks members, members of the 10-13 Club, PAL representatives, law enforcement officers and officials, and dignitaries.

As a result of the support of our members, we are proud of our charitable endeavors during the summer, which were unprecedented! This momentum is our steadfast commitment throughout the remainder of the year.

I cannot reiterate enough, my pride in our Lodge and our Members, who unwaveringly reinforce our missions – supporting our community by feeding hungry children and families, helping our veterans, our homeless, and our youth. It is the team effort and the synergy that transform "ordinary" into "extraordinary". With every attendee at our events and dinners, and every volunteer, greatness is achieved. Thank you for being a crucial part of these accomplishments!

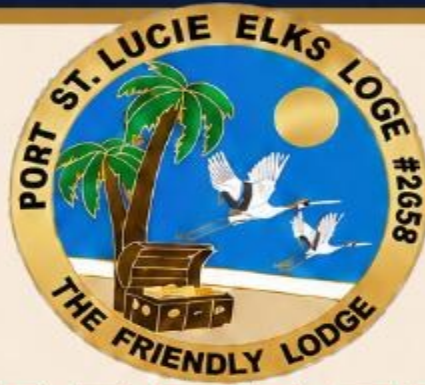

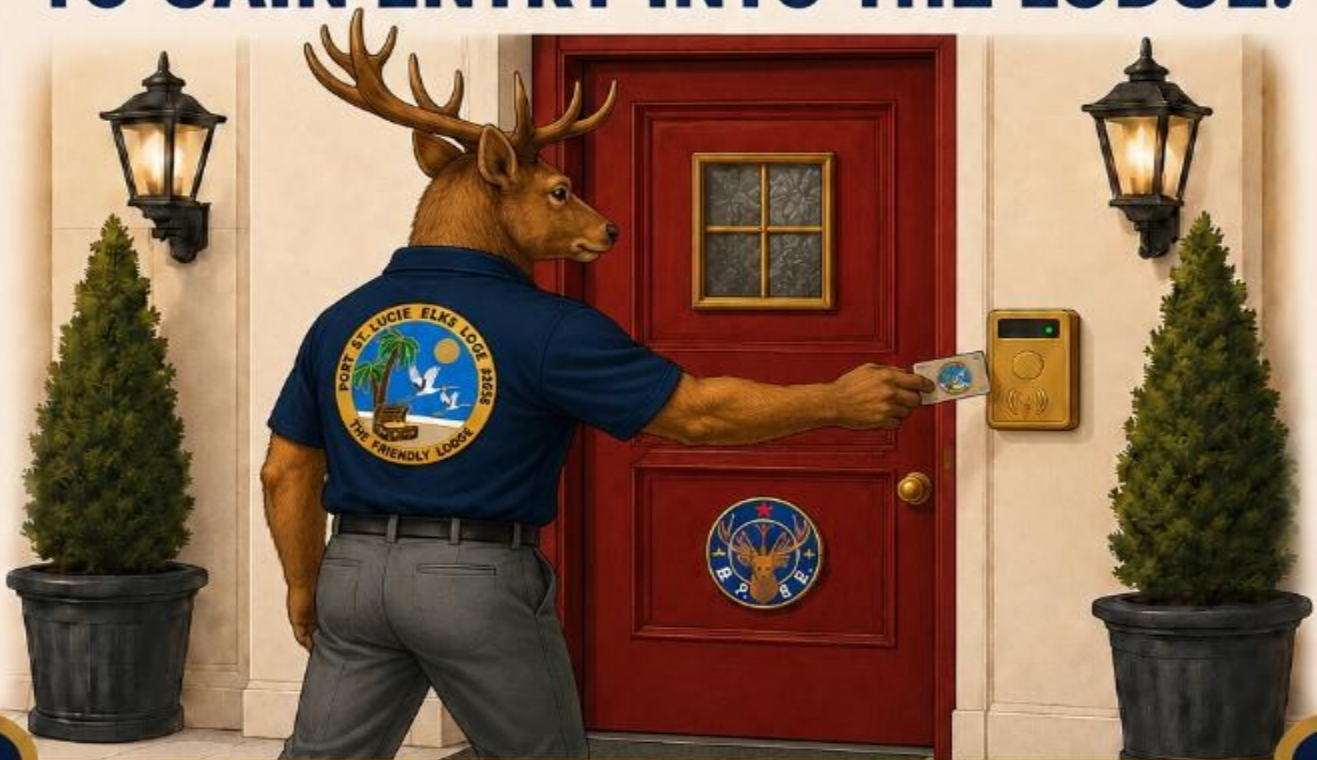

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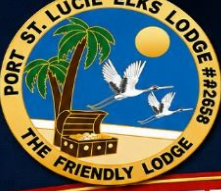
