Did you know that by donating your deer hides to your local Elks lodge you can help thousands of disabled veterans? In the past 5 years;

7,212 pairs of Wheelchair gloves were donated to disabled veterans

26,876 square feet of crafting leather was distributed to Veteran Hospitals and clinics.

421,849 Crafting and Occupational Kits were manufactured and given to disabled veterans

367,473 square feet of crafting leather was given to help heal our veterans.

3,825 deer hides were collected here in Iowa 2026

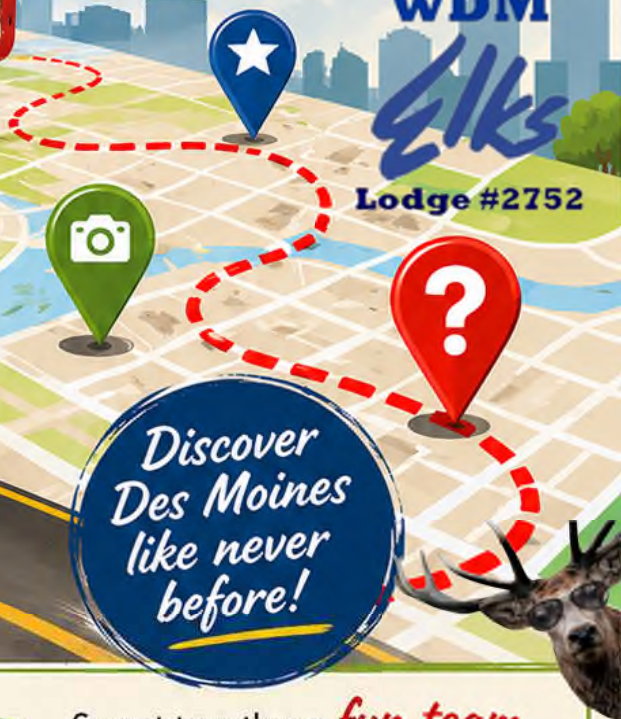
