### Queen of Hearts Promotional Drawing

Open to all Elks and those interested in becoming Elks!

- Ticket sales begin at **6 PM on the night of the week queen of hearts is played (typically Fridays), with the drawing at 8:30 PM.**
- The selected **winner will draw a card** in search of the Queen of Hearts.
- If the **Queen of Hearts is drawn**, the person wins half the pot and the deck is cleared and the game starts over the next week.
- If the winner draws another card they win prizes as follows:  
**Any card between 2 and 10's drawn wins \$50, Any ace, king, Jack or queen besides the queen of hearts wins \$100, drawing the joker wins \$200 and if the queen of hearts is drawn the winnings are half of the existing pot the week it is drawn. .**
- The remaining funds roll over to the next week, growing the pot until the Queen of Hearts is drawn. For example, if \$500 in tix is sold in week 1, the winner draws a 3 of spades, and winds \$50, \$450 carries forward to the next week and 53 of 54 cards remain to be drawn.  
If in week 2, \$550 in tix are sold the pot is then \$1,000 for that week (\$450 hold over + \$550 in weekly sales), if that week's winner draws the Ace of hearts, that person wins \$100 that night and \$900 carries forward to the next week with 52 cards left in the deck.  
The same scenario is followed each week until the queen of hearts is drawn in whatever week it is drawn.
- Once the Queen of Hearts is drawn, the game resets the next week with a new deck and all 54 cards available.
