IF YOU LIVE ALONE TAKE THIS TO BED WITH YOU EVERY NIGHT

If you live alone and you don't have one of those, "I've fallen and I can't get up" alarms, The next best thing is your car key fob. There are the LOCK and UN-LOCK buttons but there is also an ALARM button.

Press this once and the alarm sounds, press it again and it stops. You should try this just to make sure your alarm works this way. This is also handy if you forget where you parked. The alarm will sound and the lights will flash, press it again after you locate your car and it will stop. Nobody will know it was you!



If you have a spare set of keys these will be convenient because you can leave them on the nightstand so you will always have them close by if something happens during the night.

If you have to go downstairs to the basement to do laundry, take your keys with you in case of a fall. Many accidents happen in the bath/shower so have them in the bathroom, just in case.

Let your neighbors know that if your car alarm goes off it means you are in distress and need help. Leaving a contact person's name and phone number with a neighbor is helpful, but ask them to call Rescue/Police services first. In the case of a stroke or heart attack, time is of the essence.


I hope this is helpful and relieves some of the stress of living alone.
