Optional testing for hemoglobin A1C and thyroid-stimulating hormone is available at an additional cost of \$5 per test with the purchase of a blood profile.

Wellness blood profiles may be purchased at the St. Mary's Medical Campus laboratory in Ironton, Ohio, Monday through Friday (closed holidays) from 7 to 10 a.m. Lab work should be performed while fasting. Those who purchase profiles must register. For more information, call (740) 533-9720.
