Honorary Life Member Arey C. Bryant passes away



Honorary Life Member and Charter Member Arey C. Bryant, 88, of Pittsfield died on March 25, 2018. He served as Lodge Secretary for many years.

After graduating from Maine Central Institute in 1948, Arey joined the U. S. Navy and served during the Korean War as a medical corpsman, with a tour of duty in Japan treating wounded soldiers. Starting as a clerk and rural letter carrier in 1956, Arey began a long career in the U.S. Postal Service. He was promoted to postmaster in Pittsfield in 1973 and later served in the same capacity at the Rockland Post Office.

After his retirement in 1996, he served as President of the Rural Maine Letter Carriers, President of the Maine Postmasters Association, Vice President of the National Association of Postmasters (NAPUS) and President of the NAPUS Retirees of Maine.

Arey was active in Boy Scouts, Little League, Jaycees and the Kiwanis Club.

In 2006, he was elected to Honorary Life Membership in the Sebasticook Valley Elks Lodge. He also served on the SAD 53 School Board for 15 years.

Arey is survived by his life companion, Suzanne Mercier, her daughter Megan, her sons Mark and Michael, Arey's daughter Kathleen, Arey's sons Richard, Kevin and Robert, seven grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.

A public memorial service will be held at the Elks Lodge on Saturday, March 31, beginning at 1 p.m. At 2 p.m., a U.S. Navy honor guard will present a ceremonial flag to honor Arey's military service and a ceremony will be conducted by the Rev. Scott Jones.

Elks sponsoring MCI Robotics Team

In celebration of the Elks' 150th anniversary the Elks National Foundation made a \$1,500 Anniversary Grant available to all Lodges.

The grant had to be used for any of the following purposes: to relieve the poor, distressed or underprivileged; advance education; lessen the burdens of government; lessen neighborhood tensions; eliminate prejudice and discrimination; or to combat juvenile delinquency.

The Lodge voted to advance education by becoming a sponsor of the Maine Central Institute Robotics team, the Terror Bytes. The team is mentored by Aaron Basford, son of Wayne Basford, PER and Ginny Basford. The \$1,500 dollars went toward the purchase of the basic robotics kit required to participate in FIRST Robotics competitions.

The Lodge has also donated the use for the hall for fundraisers and demonstrations. The team helped the Lodge by serving at the Veterans' Day dinner.


