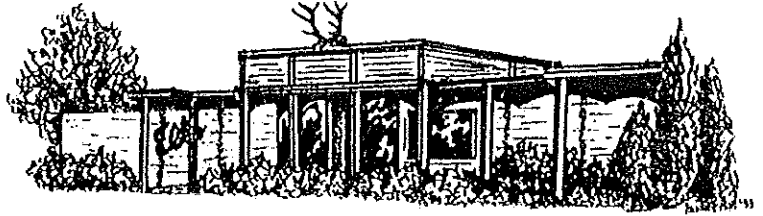

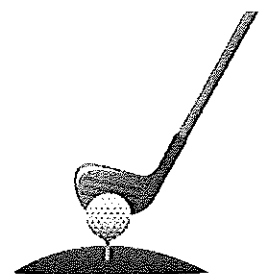

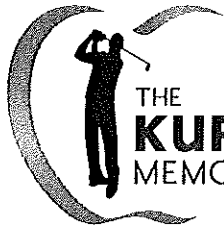

MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Kurt Schlect Memorial Scholarships for 2018 have been awarded to two veterans of the Yakima Elks Summer Golf Program—Dylan Apodaca and McKenzie Jamieson—who seek to advance their educations this fall. Each scholarship is worth \$2,000.

Apodaca will attend Perry Technical Institute aiming to become an electrical contractor, while Jamieson is headed to Seattle Pacific University with a desire for an eventual career in advertising or business.

The competitive scholarship application process was managed by the Kurt Schlect Memorial Scholarship Committee, whose members are Larry Fitzgerald (chairman), Cathy Blore, Christian Schlect, Jeff Stevens, and Helen Wendt. This independent committee was formed in 2017 with the three prong goal of encouraging future participation in Yakima Elks Junior Golf; providing educational support to worthy students with a history of past participation in our club's annual summer junior golf program; and honoring the memory of Kurt Schlect, a golfer who left the fairway much too soon.

Finances for our scholarship effort are handled by the Yakima Valley Community Foundation.

Both Dylan Apodacca and McKenzie Jamieson have been invited to the Elks Lodge on July 27 to attend the concluding luncheon for this summer's junior golfers and their parents. Our plan, with the continued financial assistance of fellow Elks and supporters of junior golf, is for two scholarships—one to a boy, one to a girl—to be made again in 2019 and annually thereafter far into the future.

Also as it gets hotter the irrigation watering time will be increased, this may cause puddling in certain low areas, please be aware of those as well.

On a brighter note, the sod projects that the crew has been doing seem to be holding up fairly well thus far. We will try our best to keep those spots healthy and happy as we head into a great summer season on the golf course.

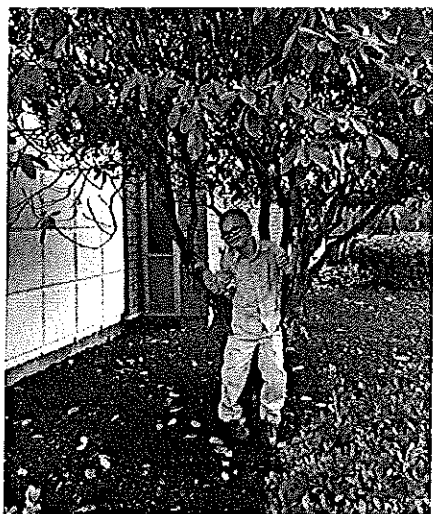

Our State Major Project

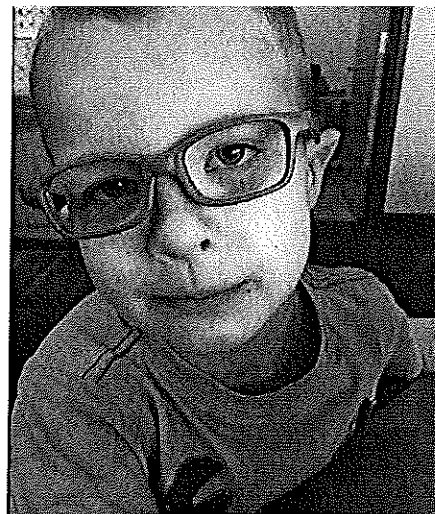


