

Page 26. ARTICLE XIII: BILLS AGAINST THE LODGE

Add to section 2. The Treasurer may pay recurring bills upon the approval of the Board of Directors without obtaining prior Lodge approval, any such payment shall be reported at the next Lodge meeting.


