1. Thursday November 8th upstairs bar will be open regular hours.
2. Bar staff will be removing all contents of the bar back refrigerators, wells, and all bar items from the sink area, and counter top of bar back. Members Bar tables and chairs must be moved back towards roll up doors to leave a ten-foot-wide clear area in front of the bar. (Lotto machine, POS, and gun syrups may remain.) All must be removed by 15:00 Friday November 9th. Angel will be responsible for coordinating Bar Staff and Volunteers to complete these items.
3. Friday November 9th 16:00 bar demolition work will begin volunteers will be needed to help move out fixtures and appliances. These items will be stored in the members bar area as the bar will be closed. No less than 6 volunteers will be required to move fixtures and appliances out of the bar back. Please contact Mark Meyers if there are any questions or to volunteer.
4. Saturday November 10th floor behind bar will be striped of loose floor covering and assessment of the full scope of floor repairs required. We will also be installing new floor sinks and waste plumbing. Volunteers will be appreciated for this step in the work but it will be crowded in the bar area so there will be limited space available. Mark and Ray will be coordinating these work activities. Please contact Mark Meyers if there are any questions or to volunteer.
5. Sunday November 11th all waste plumbing will be completed and the floor prep will be completed for the installation of new floor covering. No volunteers will be needed for this work. Please contact Mark Meyers if there are any questions.
6. Monday November 12th All American Flooring will be installing new floor covering in the bar area in the morning. At 16:00 bar appliances and fixtures will be reinstalled in the bar, once again at least 6 volunteers will be required to get this work completed. Once the appliances are reinstalled the refrigerators can be reloaded to allow them time to cool all of the contents to serving temperature, bar staff will be responsible to coordinate reloading refrigerators. Please contact Angel for restocking questions. For all other items please contact Mark Meyers if there are any questions or to volunteer.
7. Tuesday November 13th If there have been no problems in completing the appliance and fixture reinstallation the bar will reopen at 15:00 Angel will be responsible for Coordinating bar staff and volunteers to restock and setup, however if there are any remaining items to be completed this day will be available to complete those items.
