ENF Updates (Elks National Foundation)

We are off and running on our grants. We have already been approved for a Promise, Beacon and for the very first time, a Freedom Grant (thanks to our new ER, John Roe). John came up with an idea to take some of the soldiers from the Wounded Warrior Battalion turkey hunting in the Fall. He would like to pair each soldier with an Elk member for the hunt. Still ironing out some details, but if you're interested in helping with this project, please contact John.

Still waiting on approval for our Gratitude Grant. Currently, we have been approved \$7.000 in grant funds. With the possibility

of an additional \$2,500. That is not a bad return on a \$1,500 investment. Thank you to everyone who donated to ENF to help make these grants available not only for our Lodge, but for every Lodge across the U.S. This is a great way to give back to our community.

We will have already held one of our Beacon Grant events for Camp Soar by the time this bulletin is published. On May 18th, we will be helping with the Annual Fishing Derby. This is open to kids 8-17. The Derby will be held at Geary State Lake from 8:00am-noon, with lunch and prizes following the event. Pre-registration will be on the 17th at the American Legion beginning at 6pm.
