ENF Updates (Elks National Foundation):

The GER Per Capita Goal has been met! We are now eligible for all the available grants for 2020-21 year.

During the 2018-19 Lodge year, the Elks of Kansas donated \$50,823.13 to the Elks National Foundation. This year, the Foundation will give back the following: KETCH, our state's major project, \$37,430. \$16,000 for most Valuable Student Scholarships. \$7,620.00 for Veterans Service Commission.

That's a ratio of 2.163 for every dollar the Foundation received from your state last year. That doesn't even include the money Lodges in your state will get back through our <u>Community Investments Program</u>.

For the 2018-19 fiscal year, for example, we awarded a total of \$78,825.00 to 15 Kansas Lodges.

Thank you to everyone who has donated to ENF this year and previous years. We are able to do so much more in our Community through the use of these grants.
