## 2019 Christmas Baskets

December is right around the corner and at the Lodge that means we are getting ready to prepare and deliver Christmas Baskets. The process of getting ready for sharing and helping families started in September. With the help of our vendor store, Hillcrest Albertsons, we have been able to keep our costs low over the years. We budget for twelve baskets each year and then raise the total by way of donations. If we should raise more than our total, we are able to add more baskets and help more families. The working dollar amount per basket comes to \$175 but each year the final cost comes in below that amount.

Additional donations of various meats and turkeys come from members of the lodge and longtime business supporters. Items we do not purchase are candy, cookies, toothbrushes and toothpaste or any item you think would make their Holiday better. We call these gifts from the heart.

The names and contacts of families come from the Boise School District, the VA Hospital, EL Ada and members who know of families in needs. All families are double screened prior to receiving their basket.
