After dinner during the initiation non-member spouses and guests may gather and socialize with other nonmembers in the front lounge until after the initiation.

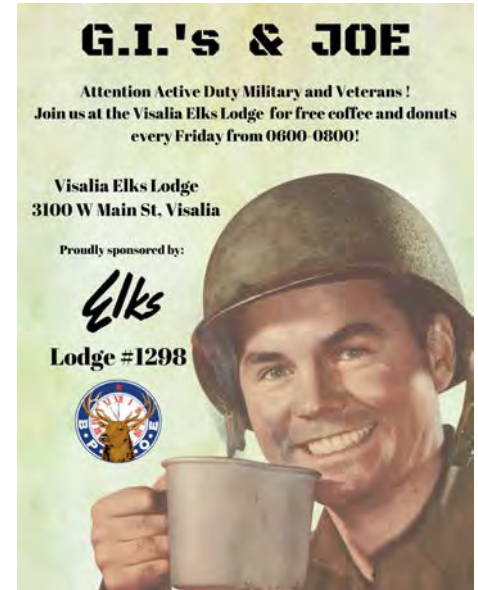
