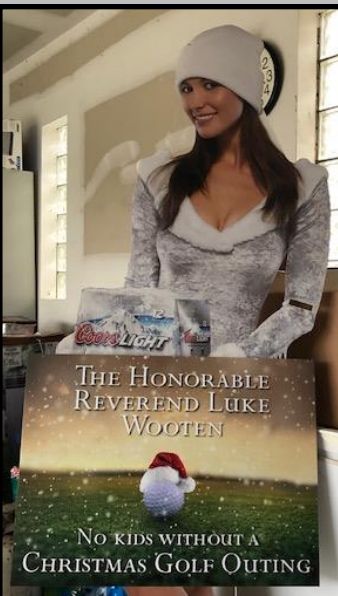

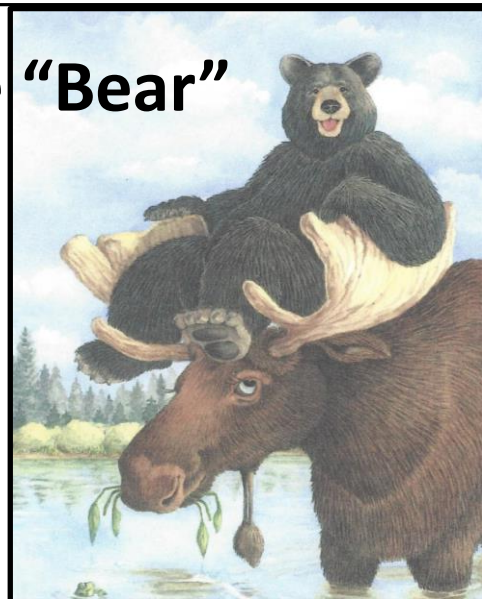
Message from the "Bear"

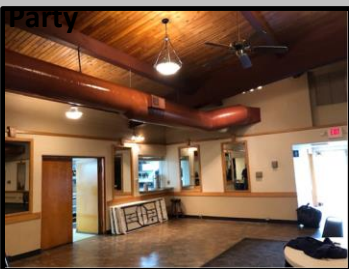
Dear fellow Elks of Lodge 1731:

There have been a lot of repairs and maintenance going on at the lodge that you may or may not realize have happened this year. It takes a great amount of dedication, time and money to do the things that need to be done to maintain our building. Please get involved in some way to make our lodge the best it can be. It is only as good as the people that are behind it.

Some of the things accomplished this year are:

- > Replace 15 ton air conditioner, 40 feet of duct work, repaint all ductwork. (Old unit was from 1967 and after 52 years of service needed to be replaced).
 - > Fix hole in the wall in kitchen (required per health inspector)
 - > Replaced 2 hot water tanks (Down stairs bar and bathrooms upstairs hall)
 - > New awnings front and rear (Construction will begin shortly)
 - > Deck power washed and stained
 - > Painted outside doors
 - > Professionally cleaned kitchen, duct work, ovens and deep cleaned kitchen
 - > Replaced exit signs and emergency lighting
 - > Replaced ramp at kitchen door
 - > Replaced beer cooler
 - > Shampooed carpet in hall
 - > Replaced all deck chairs with new ones
 - > Replaced thermostat on fryer
 - > Changed air and water filters throughout the building
 - > Repair of the wall at the front door
- (Special **"Thank You"** for those that did go the extra mile to donate, volunteer.)
We need to paint the outside of the building next spring, it is badly needed.
We hope to accomplish this project next year.

GET INVOLVED. Run a money making project for the club. Buy a ticket for a function. Make a donation. This club won't be around if our members are not involved. Your Membership Dues and drinks you buy at the bar do not begin to cover what it takes to run the lodge. There are many lodges failing mostly because of two issues. The first is letting building maintenance fall behind to the point when it's too expensive to make necessary repairs. The second is that members don't participate in events that do make money for the lodge. It's your choice as to what happens to your lodge. Be involved.
