




#### ARC/ Warrior Basketball 2020





#### We need everyone's help!!!!!

We have only 1 dumpster in the parking lot, and with that we spend over \$300 a month on trash removal. January, February, March and April are the busiest months of activity at the lodge creating lots of trash.

When the dumpster is overflowing, bags of garbage are often placed on the ground surrounding it. And the pickup company will not be able to access the dumpster to empty it — so no pickup! We absolutely cannot have that! In addition, we are encouraging rodent problems. The mess created once the bags are torn open is terrible and NO ONE wants to have to clean this up.

What can you do to help? Don't use the dumpster for trash from home or business. If you can't fit bags in the dumpster, do not leave them on the ground out there – bring it to an officer's attention. Think about what you are tossing out. Can it be compacted to save space? Make sure <u>ALL</u> boxes (large and small) are <u>ALWAYS</u> broken down. Most people do this at home without even thinking about it. So why not do it here?

It's becoming a very real problem for the guys who have to go out there and deal with it. So let's all pitch in and do our part.
