## College Dreams Come True. Thanks to Elks Scholarships

The Most Valuable Student scholarship is available to high school seniors who are United States citizens. Applicants do not need to be related to a member of the Elks. Applicants are judged on academics, leadership, service and financial need. The application is completed online and ***must be submitted by the November 15, 2020, deadline.***

The 500 national winners will be announced in April 2021, after the top 20 finalists participate in the Leadership Weekend and interview for the top awards. This year, the ENF is investing \$4.2 million in college scholarships. The ENF will award 20 top scholarships ranging from \$20,000 to \$50,000. The remaining 480 runners-up will receive \$4,000 scholarships.

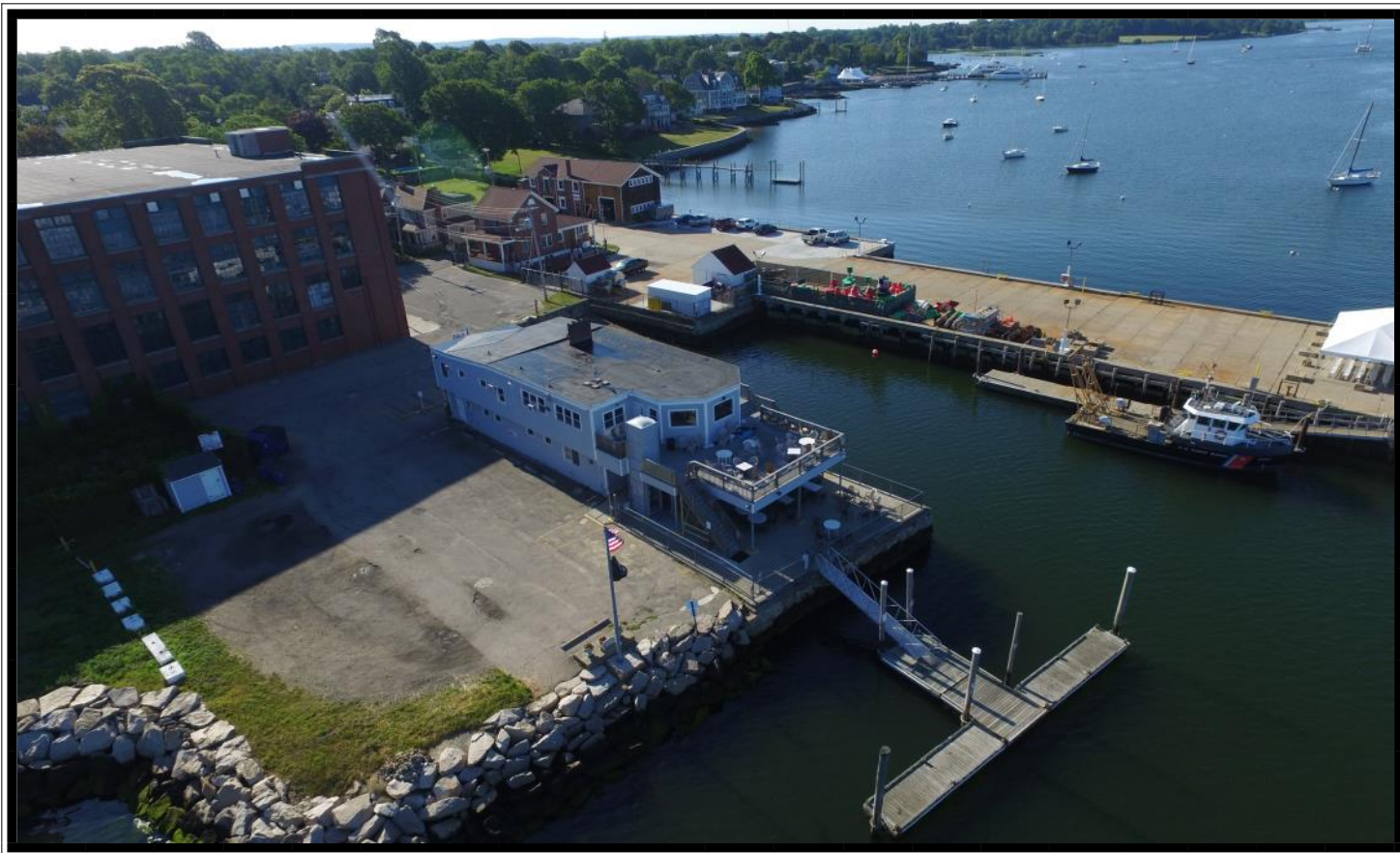
