ELIGIBILITY

Any high school student in the senior graduating class, whose parent or grandparent is an Elk in good standing of Rotterdam Lodge #2157, or was an Elk in good standing of Rotterdam Lodge #2157 at the time of his/her death, and who is a citizen of the United States of America.

MERIT STANDARDS

Scholarship, citizenship, personality, leadership, perseverance, resourcefulness, patriotism, general worthiness, and financial need are the criteria by which the applicant will be judged.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Experience has shown that the interests of the applicant are best served and the time of the Committee is conserved by neat, orderly, concise, direct, and chronological presentation on paper approximately 8 1/2 X 11 (the usual business letter size) bound flat in the form of a brief or a prospectus. Neat heavy paper binding can be procured at any stationery store. Medals, pins, athletics letters, and other such awards must not be included as exhibits, as the application material will not be returned. In addition to the "Memorandum of Required Facts," which should appear first on the cover, we require as essential, the following, preferably in the order indicated:

1. A recent photograph of the applicant (not a snapshot, yearbook type preferred) (optional).
2. A statement of not more than 300 words prepared by the applicant in his or her handwriting summarizing activities, accomplishments, and objectives of further education or professional training, which the applicant thinks qualify him or her for one of the awards.
3. The applicant's educational history from the first year of high school to date of application, evidenced by school certificates signed by proper school authority showing the courses taken, the grades received, and the rank of the applicant in the class.
4. Comprehensive letters of recommendation covering the character, personality, and scholarship of the applicant from at least one person in authority in each school attended.
5. One letter of endorsement from a responsible person (other than teachers) not related to the applicant who had an opportunity, personally, to observe the applicant and who can give worth-while opinions of the character, industry, purposefulness, disposition, and general worthiness of the applicant. If the applicant wishes to keep letters, photocopies may be submitted in lieu of original letters.
6. If space is needed for important additional information, feel free to use another piece of paper and label that information.

7. EACH APPLICATION MUST BE FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF ROTTERDAM ELKS LODGE ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31, OF THE STUDENT'S GRADUATING YEAR.
8. SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDS ARE FOR ONE YEAR ONLY.
9. ALL DECISIONS BY THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE ARE FINAL.
