started the Hearts-at-Home program back in the fall of 2016 I will never forget the smiles from one of my first veterans that we delivered furniture and household goods to. As we were bringing in his furniture he's smiling ear-to-ear. almost giddy. He says to us, "This is great, I can't believe it. It's the first time in 15 years I've had a place to live indoors." It's all I could do not to cry. This

program can be so rewarding. My husband and I need help with the program. He's not supposed to lift furniture anymore because he's on dialysis and my heart issues have gotten worse so we need help to continue this program. I can still be the liaison between the VA social workers and vets but need people to step up and help pick up furniture and deliver furniture to the vets. I can still do the shopping for them but really need help with
