**CREAMY BROCCOLI CASSEROLE by Nancy Becker**

- 1 - 16 oz frozen broccoli
- 1 - 6 oz cream of celery soup
- 1 C mayonnaise
- 1 C shredded cheddar cheese
- 2 eggs beaten
- 1/2 C crushed cheese crackers
- 2 T instant minced Onion
- 1 T margarine
