

February brings us President's Day, which is a contraction of the previously celebrated Washington and Lincoln birthdays. Called Washington's Birthday at the federal government level, it is a Holiday in the United States that is celebrated on the third Monday of February to honor all persons who served as Presidents of the United States.

Since 1879, it has been he Federal Holiday honoring George Washington, the General of the Continental Army, and subsequently the first U.S. President.

Abraham Lincoln led the Nation through the American Civil War, preserved the Union, abolished slavery and bolstered the Federal Government.

The day is also an official state holiday in most states, with names including Washington's Birthday, President's Day, Presidents' Day and Washington and Lincoln's Birthday. The various states use 15 different names. Depending on specific law, the state holiday may officially celebrate Washington alone, Washington and Lincoln, or some other combination of U.S. Presidents.

Washington's Birthday was celebrated on February 22 from 1879 until 1970. While Lincoln's Birthday was previously celebrated on February 12th of each year. To give federal employees a three-day weekend, in 1968, the Uniform Monday Holiday Act (YES, REALLY) moved it to the third Monday in February, which can occur from February 15th to the 21st. The day became known as Presidents Day.

In the following states and possessions of the United States, this same day is an official state holiday and known as Presidents' Day in Hawaii, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Puerto Rico, South Dakota, Texas, Vermont and Washington. Known as President's Day in Alaska, Idaho, Maryland, Nebraska, New Hampshire, Tennessee, West Virginia and Wyoming. Known as Presidents Day in Nevada, New Jersey and Oregon. In Maine it is known as Washington's Birthday/President's Day. In Arizona you would be celebrating Lincoln/Washington/President's Day.

In Virginia it is George Washington Day. It is Washington's Birthday in Illinois, Iowa, Massachusetts, Michigan, Louisiana and New York.

It is known as Lincoln's and Washington's Birthday in Montana. It is Washington-Lincoln Day in Colorado and Ohio. Un Utah it is known as Washington and Lincoln Day. Minnesotans celebrate Washington's and Lincoln's Birthday. In Alabama it is known as George Washington/Thomas Jefferson Birthday. In Arkansas it is known as George Washington's Birthday and Daisy Bates Day.

The holiday is not recognized at all in Delaware. And finally, ever forward thinking California calls it "The third Monday in February" however, February 12th is explicitly known as Lincoln Day and is a separate holiday.

They question you want answered is "who is Daisy Bates"? She was an American civil rights activist, publisher, journalist and lecturer who played a leading role in the Little Rock integration Crisis of 1957.

She passed away on November 4, 1999. Now you know why she has top billing with George Washington.






#### Federal Tax Savings
