### What the Elks are all about

So long as there are veterans, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks will never forget them. Our Order has a glorious history in supporting our veterans. The Elks built a 700-bed hospital in Boston and donated it to the federal government as the first VA hospital following WWI. #### DAMAGE TO THE WHITE MATTER OF THE BRAIN

**(periventricular leukomalacia, or PVL)** The white matter of the brain is responsible for transmitting signals inside the brain and to the rest of the body. Damage from PVL looks like tiny holes in the white matter of an infant's brain. These gaps in brain tissue interfere with the normal transmission of signals. Researchers have identified a period of time between 26 and 34 weeks of gestation, in which periventricular white matter is particularly sensitive to injury.
