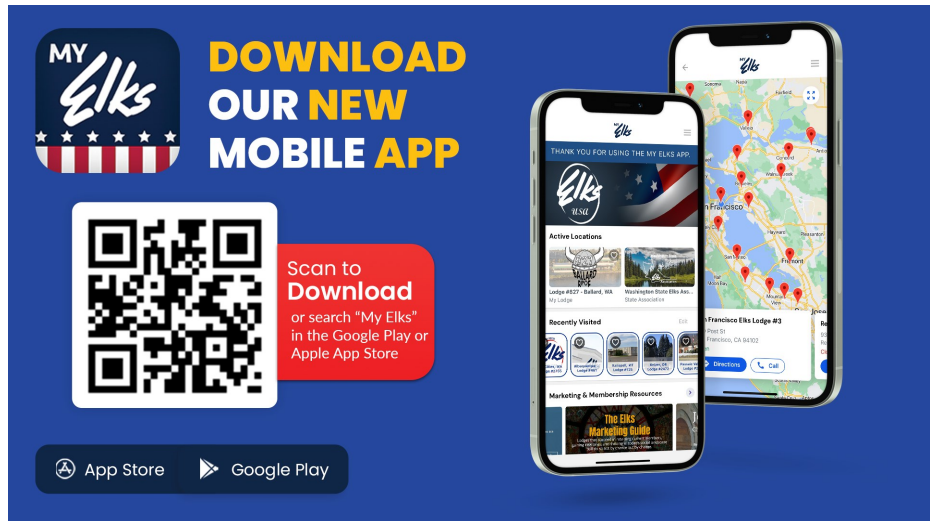
It's November? Already? Don't wait until the fourth Thursday in November to sit with family and friends to give thanks. Make every day a day of thanks and giving.

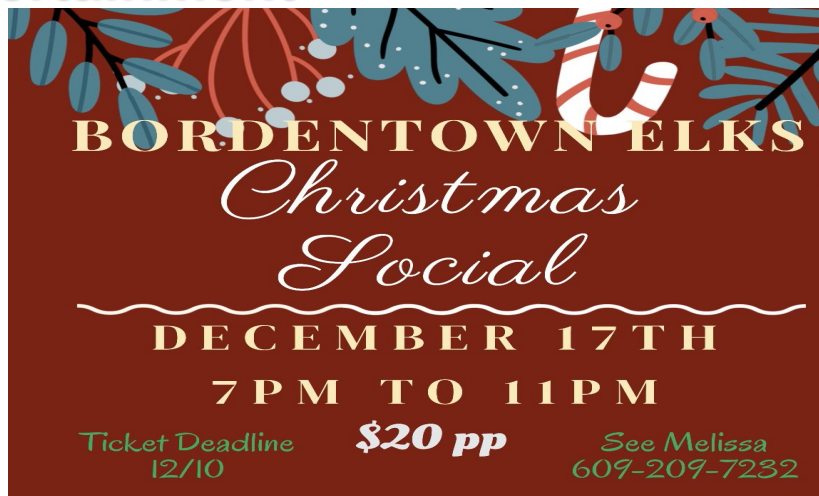
