Greetings from the Exalted Ruler,

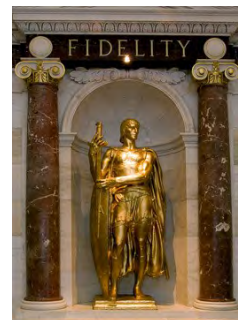

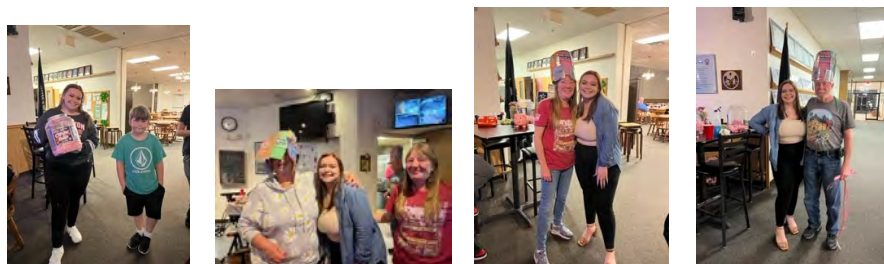
